1. Iowa DOT project: IA 12 – Gordon Dr Viaduct (TPMS #54553), Rustin St. to Virginia St. in Sioux City is programmed for a total estimated cost of \$212,092,000 with \$94,793,600 Federal participation (NHPP), \$50,098,400 in state funds (PRF), and \$67,200,000 grant application in FY 2027-2028.

1. Sioux City Transit System Light Duty Bus (176” wb) (TPMS #12116) needs to be programmed for a total estimated cost of \$198,700 with \$168,895 Federal participation (5310, 5339) in FY 2026.
