V. FY 2025-2028 & FY 2026-2029 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Amendments and Modifications –

FY 2025-2028 TIP

- The TAC members brought forward no amendments or administrative modifications to the FY2025-2028 TIP. No action taken.

FY 2026-2029 TIP Amendments

The following amendments were proposed for inclusion in the FY 2026-2029 TIP.

1. L51 from C38 to State Highway 3 in Cherokee Co needs to be programmed for a total estimated cost of \$2,500,000 with \$1,600,000 Federal participation (STBG) in FY 2027.
2. W. Bluff Street PCC replacement from N 9th Street to 30 feet west of the CN railroad track in the City of Cherokee needs to be programmed for a total estimated cost of \$630,000 with \$504,000 Federal participation (STBG-SWAP) in FY 2026.

Laura Sievers moved to approve the amendments to the FY 2026–2029 TIP, with the recommendation to include final cost details when presented to the Policy Board. Motion seconded by Brian Pearson. Motion carried with all ayes.
