Agenda

1. Survey Results
 - a. RDG provided a detailed overview of the 317 survey responses received to date. Notable points include:
 - i. 24% of respondents indicated they never bike for enjoyment or to travel to destinations
 - ii. Many respondents, about 30%, indicated they would bike more if they felt safer.
 - iii. Respondents feel that physical infrastructure would be the most effective to increase the number of trips by bicycle.
 - iv. Regarding the visual street examples, people may have gotten confused about whether bicyclists would be allowed on wide side paths. This confusion is reflected in the four-lane street segment example.
2. Priority Criteria and Routes Map
 - a. RDG provided a summary of identifying priority destination route with specific criteria.
 - b. RDG will follow up with material and a scoring sheet for committee members to rank the routes previously identified.
 - c. Matt Salvatore indicated that Hamilton Blvd from Stone Park Blvd to Outer Dr is scheduled for overlay in the following construction season. We need to decide whether there should be bike treatments on the street sooner rather than later.
 - d. Salvatore also indicated that Cristy Road is wide enough for bike lanes along the Elk Creek subdivision.
3. Facility Application
 - a. RDG detailed the types of facilities that would likely be applied in the Sioux City bike network.
4. Barrier Points
 - a. RDG has started to list potential barriers along routes such as untreated intersections. Committee members should help identify these barriers when scoring the routes
