- FY 2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Amendments and Administrative Modifications – Corinne presented the following amendments and administrative modifications to the FY 2023-2026 TIP.
 - 1. 110th Street Bridge in Woodbury County needs to be programmed for a total estimated cost of \$1,000,000 with \$800,000 Federal participation (HBP/STBG) in FY 23.
 - 2. East Willow Street Bridge in the City of Cherokee needs to be programmed for a total estimated cost of \$650,000 Federal participation (HBP/STBG) in FY 23.

Keith Radig moved to approve the amendments presented, seconded by Mike Donlin. Motion carried all ayes.

VI. Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG)/Transportation Alternative Program (TAP) <u>Deadlines and Application Process</u> – Corinne presented the application process for the STBG/TAP and proposed deadline for the next application round. Corinne noted the applications will be distributed on January 13th with a due date of February 17th. Corinne also noted the TAC made a positive recommendation for approval.
