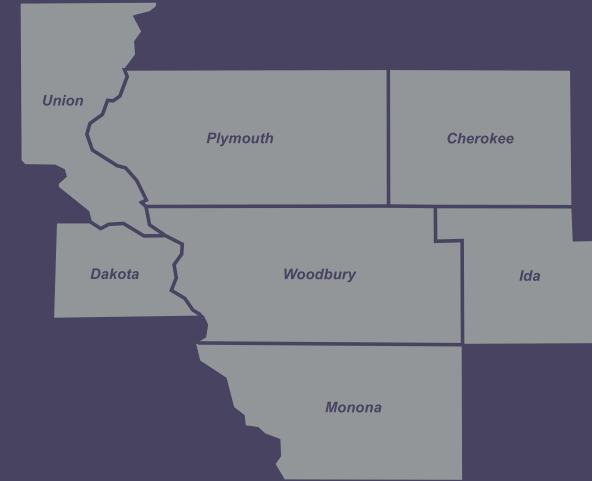

2022 Accomplishments

SIMPCO is a catalyst for regional cooperation, uniting local governments in the Tri-State Siouxland region. We partner with local governments in long-range planning, community development activities, and regional program management to foster intelligent growth, economic development, and safe, accessible transportation.



INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS

- Through SIMPCO's Transportation Improvement Program, \$346 million in Federal, State and local funds are programmed (FY 2023 – 2026) for regional transportation projects.
- \$8.5 million in grant funds were secured for bicycle and pedestrian improvement projects in the Siouxland area.
- \$5 million in grants funds were awarded to communities for water and wastewater infrastructure improvements.
- Four planning studies were completed in the Sioux City metropolitan area to improve transportation for vehicles, freight, transit, bicycle and pedestrian.



DIVERSE, AFFORDABLE AND MARKET-RATE HOUSING:

- SIMPCO housing programs expended over half a million dollars in grant funds for housing rehab projects throughout the region.
- SIMPCO housing programs rehabilitated 20 owner-occupied homes in the past year.
- SIMPCO contracted with 10 local contractors and sub-contractors for rehabilitation projects in the last year to complete homeowner occupied rehabilitation projects.
- SIMPCO was awarded \$21,000 to conduct a housing study for Dakota County, Nebraska.



ECONOMIC & WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

- SIMPCO was awarded approximately \$154,000 in assistance from U.S. EDA, Iowa Economic Development Authority and Nebraska Department of Economic Development to be used for economic development planning, research, and technical services throughout the region.
- SIMPCO assisted six members with grant applications related to economic and workforce development equaling \$2.9 million in awarded funds.
- SIMPCO continues to work with state and regional economic development organizations on issues related to economic development, such as broadband, business startups, and automation.
- SIMPCO completed two economic development research plans to assist with future economic development projects.



QUALITY OF LIFE:

- SIMPCO assisted with two award winning grants equaling \$400,000 for Siouxland communities to improve community spaces.
- SIMPCO was awarded \$71,000 in funds to help initiative quality of life improvements for senior citizens and children within the Siouxland area.
- SIMPCO created and distributed an updated edition of the Metro Trails map.
- SIMPCO completed an Extended Corridor Study for the Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC)
