A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE 2045 LONG RANGE TRANSPORTATION PLAN FOR THE SIOUXLAND INTERSTATE METROPOLITAN PLANNING COUNCIL (SIMPCO) METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION

WHEREAS The Siouxland Interstate Metropolitan Planning Council (SIMPCO) is designated as the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Sioux City Urbanized Area; and

WHEREAS, a Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) is required by the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) and was developed by the MPO for the Sioux City metropolitan area; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Policy Board of the SIMPCO Metropolitan Planning Organization approves and adopts the amendments to the MPO 2045 Long Range Transportation Plan including adding the Westside Trail in South Sioux City.
