Owner-Occupied Repair Housing Program



Designed to help low-to-moderate income homeowners maintain their homes in safe, healthy, and livable conditions.

Service area includes Cherokee, Ida, Monona, Plymouth, and Woodbury counties in Iowa (excluding Sioux City)

Program Requirements

- All households assisted shall have a gross annual income under 80% of the county SHTF income limit (see table)
- Property must be located
 within Cherokee, Ida, Monona,
 Plymouth, or Woodbury
 County (excluding Sioux City).
- 8 Property must be a singlefamily unit.
- Applicants shall own and occupy the property to be assisted and shall be current on taxes, utilities, mortgage payments, and must have homeowner's insurance.
- Homeowner must agree to a five (5) year forgivable deed restriction for the amount of funding provided. Amount is reduced 1/60 for every month the homeowner resides in home.
- Applicants are required to provide detailed financial infomration for any person 18+ in the household.

Our Mission

To further the preservation and development of affordable housing and grow affordable housing opportunities for low-to-moderate income households in the service area of Cherokee, Ida, Monona, Plymouth and Woodbury counties.

Eligible Repairs

Repair or replacement of heating, electrical, plumbing systems, roofing, windows, ADA accessibility, and other repair necessary to address substandard health or safety conditions.

Ineligible Repairs

Kitchen appliances, landscaping, additions, sheds, garages, fireplaces, patios, decks, fences, water softeners, sidewalks, and any cosmetic work (unless deemed hazardous)
