 2. Iowa 12 pavement rehab project from Military Road in Sioux City to S Jct. IA 3 needs to be programmed for a total estimated cost of \$2,000,000 with \$1,600,000 Federal participation (NHPP) and \$400,000 State participation (PRF) in FY 2024.
 3. US 20 pavement rehab and paved shoulder strengthening from Nebraska to 0.4 miles east of county road D22 needs to be programmed for a total estimated cost of \$13,000,750 with \$3,879,477 Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP), \$7,821,198 National Highway Performance Program (NHPP) and \$1,300,075 State participation (PRF) in FY 24.
