Due to road construction, there are only two access points to the SIMPCO/SRTS facility:

1. From North, South and West: Gordon Drive to 4301 Stone Avenue (Casey's General Store) to continue north on Stone Avenue which turns left into 155th until reaching Benton Avenue. Turn Right on Benton Avenue and turn left to the north entry of DOT and SIMPCO/SRTS Facility
2. From East (Hwy 20): Turn right on Charles Avenue from Hwy 20, left on Correctionville Road, to left on Buchanan Avenue, then right on 155th to left on Benton Avenue. Turn left to the north entry of DOT and SIMPCO/SRTS Facility.
